Start Here!

It's Simple!

- Everyone bets, no matter who is "shooting" (rolling the dice).
- 1. Once the "Marker" says OFF, place a bet on the PASS LINE. (\$5)
- 2. The next roll of the dice is called the "Come Out" roll!
- a. 7 or 11 You WIN! Take your chips! Back to Step 1.
- b. 2, 3 or 12 You LOSE! Back to Step 1.
- c. any other number Becomes The POINT!
- 3. Now it's only about the 7 and *The Point*! The shooter rolls.
- a. The POINT You WIN! Take your chips! Back to Step 1.
- b. 7 You LOSE! Back to Step 1.
- c. Any other number nothing happens. Back to Step 3.
- "Come Out" (1st) roll, 7 or 11 you win. 2,3 or 12 you lose.
- After that "point" you win, 7 you lose.

That's It! It's that Easy!

"ODDS" Bet

- 1. After a Point is established, Place a bet behind your PASS LINE bet. (\$10)
- 2. Now it's only about the 7 and The Point!
 - a. The POINT You WIN! Take your chips! Payment schedule:

POINT odds

- 4 or 10 = 2:1 (your \$20 bet will receive \$40)
- = 3:2 (your \$20 bet will receive \$30) 5 or 9
- = 6:5 (your \$20 bet will receive \$24) 6 or 8
- b. 7 You LOSE!
- c. Any other number nothing happens

"PLACE" Bet

1. At any time, ask the dealer to place your bet on one of the numbers across the top of the table. The "Marker"

is placed on

"The Point". -

- During the

"Come out"

roll it says

"Off"


- 2. Now it's only about the 7 and That Number!
- a. That number You WIN! Receive your chips! Payment schedule:

POINT odds

- = 9:5 (your \$20 bet will receive \$36) 4 or 10
- = 7:5 (your \$20 bet will receive \$28) 5 or 9
- 6 or 8 = 7:6 (your \$24 bet will receive \$28)

b. 7 - You LOSE!

c. Any other number – nothing happens



Place your chip in front of you, on the PASS LINE
